- Articles contain original research (scientific experiments, surveys, research studies)
- A list of references provided at the end of each article
- published in scholarly or academic journals called "peer-reviewed" or "refereed."

- Parts of a standard empirical research article:
 - Abstract
 - Introduction
 - Method
 - Results
 - Discussion
 - References
- Empirical articles include charts, graphs, or statistical analysis
